3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE HOSPITAL'S PROGRAM

FOR CIVILLY COMMITTED SEXUALLY DANGEROUS INDIVIDUALS. During the 2013-14 6 interim the legislative management shall consider studying the state hospital's program for the 7 evaluation and treatment of civilly committed sexually dangerous individuals. The study must 8 include a review of the program's history, progress, costs, policies and procedures, and the 9 impact of the program on the families of individuals who are civilly committed to the program. 10 The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any 11 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fourth legislative assembly.
