- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 27-05-30 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to judicial referees.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-05-30 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 27-05-30. Judicial referees.
- 7 1. There may be appointed in each judicial district, by The presiding judge of a judicial
- 8 <u>district, on behalf of</u> the judges of the district court having jurisdiction therein, may
- 9 <u>appoint</u> one or more referees to serve on a full-time or part-time basis. A referee is
- entitled to receive a salary within the limits of legislative appropriation.
- 11 2. A district court In accordance with rules of the supreme court, the presiding judge may
- assign a referee to preside in any case or proceeding provided for in chapter
- 13 <u>12.1-31.2</u>, title 14, <u>sections 20.1-01-28 and 20.1-01-29</u>, chapter 27-20, <del>and</del> chapter
- 14 28-25 pursuant to rules of the supreme court, subsection 6 of section 50-09-08.6, and
- 15 subsection 2 of section 50-09-14.
- 16 3. The supreme court may promulgate rules for the qualification of referees, the extent
- and assignment of authority by the district court judges of the judicial districts presiding
- 18 <u>judge</u>, procedure, and the conduct of the office, including regulations for training
- 19 sessions and continuing education.
