1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 61-36-01, 61-36-02, and 61-36-04 of the

2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the composition and duties of the Devils Lake outlets

3 management advisory committee; and to repeal section 61-36-03 of the North Dakota Century

4 Code, relating to compensation and expenses of the Devils Lake outlet management advisory

5 committee.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 61-36-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
8 amended and reenacted as follows:

9 61-36-01. Devils Lake outletoutlets management advisory committee - Members -

10 **Terms - Vacancies**.

11 1. The Devils Lake outletoutlets management advisory committee consists of the state-12 engineer or the state engineer's designee, one member appointed by the Red River-13 joint water resource board, one member appointed by the Devils Lake joint water 14 resource board, one member appointed by the upper Sheyenne River joint water-15 resource board, one county commissioner from Ramsey County appointed by the 16 Ramsey County board of county commissioners, one county commissioner from-17 Benson County appointed by the Benson County board of county commissioners, a 18 representative of the Spirit Lake Nation appointed by the tribal council of the Spirit 19 Lake Nation, and three members appointed by the governor. The members appointed 20 by the governor must represent the interests affected by downstream impacts of 21 operating an outlet to Devils Lake. An appointed member may designate a substitute 22 to serve in that person's capacity at such meetings that person may be unable to-23 attend. Except for the first term, all appointed members serve for a term of four years 24 or until their successors are appointed and qualified. For the first term, two of the

3		rep	resenting the interests affected by downstream impacts of operating an outlet to

15		<u>i.</u>	A representative from Barnes County appointed by the governor;
16		<u>j.</u>	A representative from Valley City appointed by the governor;
17		<u>k.</u>	A representative from Lisbon or Fort Ransom appointed by the governor;
18		<u>l.</u>	A representative from Fargo appointed by the governor;
19		<u>m.</u>	A representative from Grand Forks appointed by the governor;
20		<u>n.</u>	The governor of Minnesota or a designee appointed by the governor of
21			<u>Minnesota;</u>
22		<u>0.</u>	The premier of Manitoba or the premier's designee; and
23		<u>p.</u>	A member of the house and a member of the senate who represent, one
24			representing the Devils Lake basin region and one representing the downstream
25			region, appointed by the chairman of the legislative management.
26	<u>2.</u>	<u>All</u>	appointed members serve for a term of four years or until their successors are
27		app	pointed and qualified.
28	<u>3.</u>	Ter	ms expire on the first day of July. Each appointed member must be a qualified
29		ele	ctor of the state and is subject to removal by judicial procedure.
30	<u>4.</u>	<u>The</u>	e terms of appointed members must be staggered by lot so that at least three of the
31		<u>terr</u>	ns expire each year.

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1	<u>5.</u>	Members of the committee may be reappointed for additional terms and except for the		
2		legislative members, serve at the pleasure of the governor.		
3	<u>6.</u>	A vacancy must be filled in the same manner as original appointments for the		
4		remainder of the unexpired term. Before entering upon the discharge of official duties,		
5		each appointed member shall take, subscribe, and file with the secretary of state the		
6		oath prescribed for civil officers.		
7	SEC	CTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 61-36-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
8	amended and reenacted as follows:			
9	61-3	36-02. Chairman - Quorum - Meetings.		
10	The	state engineergovernor or governor's designee is the chairman of the committee. A		
11	majority	of the members of the committee constitutes a quorum. The committee mayshall hold		
12	meeting	s at the call of the chairman or at the request of three membersbefore initial operation of		
13	the com	mitteeoutlets, and at such other times and places as the chairman providesdeems		
14	necessa	ary.		
15	SEC	CTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 61-36-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
16	amende	d and reenacted as follows:
