- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 43-05 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the powers of the board of podiatric medicine in investigating and
- 3 prosecuting complaints.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 43-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:
- 7 **Powers of the board.**
- 8 The board may:
- 9 <u>1. Subpoena witnesses and podiatrists and hospital records relating to the practice of </u>
- any podiatrist under investigation. The confidentiality of peer review records under
- chapter 23-34 or by any other statute or law does not affect the subpoena nor the
- 12 <u>admissibility of the records in board proceedings.</u>
- 13 <u>2. Hold preliminary hearings.</u>
- 14 3. Upon probable cause, require any podiatrist under investigation to submit to a
- physical, psychiatric, or competency examination or chemical dependency evaluation.
- 16 <u>4. Appoint special masters to conduct preliminary hearings.</u>
- 5. Employ independent investigators when necessary.
- 18 <u>6. Hold confidential conferences with any complainant or podiatrist with respect to any</u>
- 19 <u>complaint.</u>
- 20 <u>7. File a formal complaint against any licensed podiatrist with the board of podiatric</u>
- 21 medicine.
