- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 39-10-48 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to traffic citations on the capitol grounds during a legislative session.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 39-10-48 of the North Dakota Century
Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 4. Whenever any authorized law enforcement officer finds, on state charitable or penal
- 7 institution property or on the state capitol grounds, a vehicle standing, stopped, or
- 8 parked in a dangerous location or in violation of any official traffic-control device
- 9 prohibiting or restricting the stopping, standing, or parking of any vehicle, the officer
- 10 shall place a written warning on the vehicle for the first offense and thereafter an
- 11 authorized traffic citation may be issued. However, no traffic citation may be issued for-
- a violation of this subsection occurring on the state capitol grounds during a legislative
 session.
