- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 secretary of state and public printing; to provide exemptions; to amend and reenact section
- 3 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary of the secretary of state; and
- 4 to provide for reports to the budget section.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 9 other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 10 secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending 11 June 30, 2015, as follows: 12 Subdivision 1.

30	legislative assembly on the use of the one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013,						
31	and ending June 30, 2015.						

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1 SECTION 3. EXEMPTION - GENERAL SERVICES OPERATING FUND. Any unexpended 2 and unobligated balance remaining in the secretary of state's general services operating fund 3 on June 30, 2013, is not subject to the provisions of section 54-09-08, and any unexpended 4 funds are available and may be expended by the secretary of state, during the biennium 5 beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, for the database and processing platform 6 migration project. 7 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is 8 amended and reenacted as follows: 9 54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state. 10 The annual salary of the secretary of state is ninety-ninety-six thousand threeseven hundred 11 sixtyninety-four dollars through June 30, 20122014, and ninety-threeninety-nine thousand 12 seventy-onesix hundred ninety-eight dollars thereafter. 13 SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - MAINFRAME MIGRATION COMPUTER PROJECT. 14 Unexpended funding of \$1,750,000 provided in the operating expenses line item of 15 subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 28 of the 2011 Session Laws is not subject to the 16 provisions of section 54-44.1-11 at the end of the 2011-13 biennium and may be continued into 17 the 2013-15 biennium for the completion of the mainframe migration computer project. 18 SECTION 6. NEW FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS - LIMITED AUTHORIZATION. 19 The two new full-time equivalent business registration unit positions and the one new full-time 20 equivalent business information unit position included in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act 21 are authorized only for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. The 22 secretary of state shall reevaluate these positions after the completion of the mainframe 23 migration computer project to determine if the positions will be requested as part of the agency's 24 2015-17 biennium budget request as optional items. 25 SECTION 7. CREDIT CARD FEES - BUDGET SECTION REPORTS. The secretary of 26 state shall report semiannually to the budget section during the 2013-14 interim regarding credit 27 card usage rates and credit card fees paid by the secretary of state.
