- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the attorney general;
- 2 to amend and reenact section 54-12-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary
- 3 of the attorney general; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the attorney general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the attorney general, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

- 14 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the
- 15 2015-17 biennium. The attorney general shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 16 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning
- 17 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

## 18 SECTION 3. ATTORNEY GENERAL REFUND FUND TRANSFER TO THE GENERAL

- 19 **FUND EXEMPTION.** Notwithstanding section 54-12-18, the attorney general may retain the
- 20 balance in the attorney general refund fund that would otherwise be transferred to the general
- 21 fund on June 30, 2013.
- **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-12-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 23 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 54-12-11. Salary of attorney general.
- The annual salary of the attorney general is one hundred thirty-fourforty-three thousand
- 26 onesix hundred thirty-five eighty-five dollars through June 30, 20122014, and one hundred
- 27 thirty-eightforty-nine thousand one four hundred fifty-nine thirty-two dollars thereafter.
- **SECTION 5. EMERGENCY.** Section 3 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
