- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state department
- 2 of health; to repeal section 23-46-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to state
- 3 financial assistance for emergency medical services; and to provide legislative intent.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state department of health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state department of health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

16	2015-17 biennium. The state department of health shall report to the appropriations committees					
17	of the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium					
18	beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.					
19	SECTION 3. ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND. The estimated					
20	income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$272,310, or so much of the sum as					
21	may be necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the environment					
22	and rangeland protection fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30,					
23	2015. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the North Dakota stockmen's association					
24	environmental services program.					
25	SECTION 4. TOBACCO PREVENTION AND CONTROL TRUST FUND. The estimated					
26	income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$383,000 from the tobacco prevention					
27	and control trust fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.					
28	SECTION 4. INTENT - INDIRECT COST RECOVERIES. Notwithstanding section					
29	54-44.1-15, the state department of health may deposit indirect cost recoveries in its operating					
30	account.					

- 1 SECTION 5. FOLLOWUP COLORECTAL SCREENING GUIDELINES. The grants line item
- 2 included in section 1 of this Act includes \$160,200 from the general fund for recommended
- 3 followup colorectal screenings. These funds may be spent for the cost of recommended
- 4 followup colorectal screenings of up to \$1,800 per screening for the biennium beginning July 1,
- 5 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
- 6 **SECTION 6. REPEAL.** Section 23-46-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
