1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol:

2 and to provide a contingent appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway
patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

22 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning

23 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

SECTION 3. CONTINGENT APPROPRIATION - LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING

25 **FACILITIES.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury,

not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$6,651,000, or so much of the sum as may be

- 27 necessary, to the highway patrol for the purpose of constructing law enforcement training
- 28 facilities in the Devils Lake area, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30,

29 2015. The highway patrol shall coordinate with lake region state college regarding the types of

30 facilities to be constructed and the locations for the facilities. The funding provided under this

31 section is available to the highway patrol only if actual general fund revenues for the period

1 July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014, exceed estimated general fund revenues for that period by 2 at least \$200,000,000, as determined by the office of management and budget, based on the 3 legislative estimates made at the close of the 2013 regular legislative session. The funding 4 provided under this section is considered one-time funding and the highway patrol shall report 5 to the appropriations committees of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly regarding the use of 6 the funding. 7 SECTION 4. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER. The less estimated income line item in 8 section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$7,169,296\$6,091,755, or so much of the sum as may 9 be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the 10 direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses 11 of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. 12 SECTION 5. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS. Each patrol officer of the 13 state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an 14 amount not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending 15 June 30, 2015. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses, 16 except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at their respective 17 home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are 18 paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or 19 other memorandums.
