- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 57-38-30.5 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the effect of the expiration of the federal research tax credit

3 on the state income tax credit for research and experimental expenditures; and to provide for

4 retroactive application; and to provide an expiration date.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new subsection to section 57-38-30.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is 7 created and enacted as follows:
- 8 For any taxable year in which the federal research tax credit provisions of section 41
- 9 of the Internal Revenue Code are ineffective, the provisions of section 41 of the
- 10 Internal Revenue Code referenced in this section have the same meaning and
- 11 application as provided in section 41 of the Internal Revenue Code [26 U.S.C. 41], as
- 12 <u>amended through the most recent taxable year in which the provisions were in effect.</u>
- 13 SECTION 2. RETROACTIVE APPLICATION. This Act applies retroactively to taxable years
- 14 beginning after December 31, 2011.
- 15 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through December 31, 2014, and
- 16 after that date is ineffective.
