HOUSE BILL NO. 1155 (Representatives Delmore, Hogan, K. Koppelman, Maragos) (Senators Lyson, Nelson)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 54-23.4-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to compensation for criminally injurious conduct reporting requirement.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 54-23.4-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

4. Compensation may not be awarded unless the criminally injurious conduct resulting in injury or death was reported to a law enforcement officer within seventy-two<u>ninety-six</u> hours after its occurrence or the division finds there was good cause for the failure to report within that time. In the case of child abuse or sexual molestation of a child, the criminally injurious conduct must be reported to a law enforcement officer within three years after the child reaches the age of majority.
