AN ACT to amend and reenact subdivision b of subsection 5 of section 53-06.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to rent allowed for gaming machines.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision b of subsection 5 of section 53-06.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

b. If twenty-one and paddlewheels are not conducted but pull tabs is conducted involving <u>either</u> a jar bar or dispensing device, <u>but notor</u> both, the monthly rent may not exceed two <u>hundred seventy-fivefour hundred</u> dollars. If <u>pull tabs is conducted</u> involving both a jar <u>bar and dispensing device</u>, the monthly rent for pull tabs may not exceed three hundred dollars. S. B. NO. 2177 - PAGE 2
