1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 6-09.10-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to the confidentiality of mediation.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 6-09.10-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **6-09.10-10. Mediation - Open records and meetings exception.**

7 1. a. Information created, collected, ~~and~~or maintained, by the North Dakota mediation  
8 service, in the course of any formal or informal mediation, is confidential and not  
9 subject to the open records requirements of section 44-04-18. The information  
10 may be released only upon the written consent of all parties to the mediation or  
11 pursuant to an order issued by the court upon a showing of good cause.

12 b. (1) Mediation communication is confidential and not subject to the open records  
13 requirements of section 44-04-18. Mediation communication may be  
14 released only upon the written consent of all parties to the mediation or  
15 pursuant to an order issued by the court upon a showing of good cause.

16 (2) For purposes of this subdivision, "mediation communication" means a  
17 written statement, and an oral statement or any nonverbal communication,  
18 either of which must be inscribed on a tangible medium or stored in a  
19 medium that is retrievable in perceivable form, provided the communication  
20 occurs during a mediation or is made for purposes of considering, initiating,  
21 conducting, continuing, or reconvening a mediation.

22 2. All mediation meetings and meetings involving the board, negotiators, mediators, or  
23 other personnel are confidential, closed meetings and are not subject to the open

- 1 meetings requirements of section 44-04-19, if the finances of specific farmers,
