1 A concurrent resolution urging Congress to pursue enactment of the Regulations from the  
2 Executive in Need of Scrutiny Act introduced by Senator Paul in February 2013 requiring  
3 Congress to approve every major rule proposed by the Executive Branch which has an annual  
4 economic impact of one hundred million dollars or more, before it can be enforced on the  
5 American people.

6 **WHEREAS**, Section 1 of article I of the United States Constitution grants all legislative  
7 powers to Congress; and

8 **WHEREAS**, Congress has excessively delegated its constitutional responsibilities while  
9 failing to conduct appropriate oversight and retain accountability for the content of the laws it  
10 passes; and

11 **WHEREAS**, federal agencies promulgating rules through the regulatory process are over  
12 reaching their authority without transparency or accountability to the people of the United  
13 States;

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
15 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

16 That the Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly urges Congress to pursue enactment of the  
17 Regulations from the Executive in Need of Scrutiny Act introduced by Senator Paul in  
18 February 2013 requiring Congress to approve every major rule proposed by the Executive  
19 Branch which has an annual economic impact of one hundred million dollars or more, before it  
20 can be enforced on the American people.

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution  
22 to each member of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation, to the Majority Leader and  
23 Minority Leader of the United States Senate, and to the Majority Leader and Minority Leader of  
24 the United States House of Representatives.
