

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3055**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the feasibility and  
2 possible benefits of allowing members of the Legislative Assembly and other state employees to  
3 receive by electronic means all information regarding pay and benefits and other information  
4 shared by the employer and to study the availability of recycling options in all state buildings.

5 **WHEREAS**, state employees and members of the Legislative Assembly receive and utilize  
6 a significant amount of paper and recycling options are not always available in state buildings;  
7 and

8 **WHEREAS**, most large institutions utilize electronic communication programs, including  
9 electronic mail and data sharing; and

10 **WHEREAS**, all state employees and members of the Legislative Assembly already have  
11 access to the PeopleSoft portal for human resource management, personal information  
12 collection, and information on pay and benefits;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
14 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

15 That the Legislative Management study the feasibility and possible benefits of allowing  
16 members of the Legislative Assembly and other state employees to receive by electronic means  
17 all information regarding pay and benefits and other information shared by the employer and  
18 study the availability of recycling options in all state buildings; and

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and  
20 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
21 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
