- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to compiling and reporting of scholarship information; to amend and
- 3 reenact sections 15-62.2-02 and 15.1-21-02.6 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the

4 student financial assistance grant program and North Dakota scholarships; and to provide

5 appropriations.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
8 and enacted as follows:

- 9 State board of higher education Compiling and reporting scholarship information.
- 10 The North Dakota university system shall utilize the state longitudinal data system to
- 11 <u>compile the graduation rates of students who received either the North Dakota academic</u>

12 <u>scholarship or the North Dakota career and technical education scholarship. The North Dakota</u>

- 13 university system shall provide the compiled report annually to the legislative management.
- 14 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15-62.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:

16 **15-62.2-02. State board of higher education - Powers and duties.**

- 17 The state board of higher education shall:
- Administer the North Dakota student financial assistance program and the North
 Dakota scholars program and adopt functional rules regarding the eligibility and
 selection of grant and scholarship recipients.
- Determine the amount of individual grants, which may not exceed one thousand six
 hundred fiftytwo thousand dollars per recipient per academic year, under the North
 Dakota student financial assistance program.

16				semester during which the student is enrolled full time at an accredited

18				point average of <u>at least</u> 2.75 on a 4.0 grading scale.					
19		b.	<u>(2)</u>	The state board of higher education shall provide to any student who					
20				graduates from high school before the 2014-15 school year and who is					
21				certified as being eligible by the superintendent of public instruction either a					
22				North Dakota academic scholarship or a North Dakota career and technical					
23				education scholarship, in the amount of five hundred dollars, for each					
24				quarter during which the student is enrolled full time at an accredited					
25				institution of higher education in this state and maintains a cumulative grade					
26				point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 grading scale.					
27		<u>b.</u>	<u>(1)</u>	The state board of higher education shall provide to any student who					
28				graduates from high school during or after the 2014-15 school year and who					
29				is certified as being eligible by the superintendent of public instruction either					
30				a North Dakota academic scholarship or a North Dakota career and					
31				technical education scholarship, in the amount of one thousand dollars, for					

1				each semester during which the student is enrolled full time at an accredited	
2				institution of higher education in this state and maintains a cumulative grade	
3				point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 grading scale.	
4			<u>(2)</u>	The state board of higher education shall provide to any student who	
5				graduates from high school during or after the 2014-15 school year and is	
6				certified as being eligible by the superintendent of public instruction either a	
7				North Dakota academic scholarship or a North Dakota career and technical	
8				education scholarship, in the amount of six hundred sixty-six dollars, for	
9				each quarter during which the student is enrolled full time at an accredited	
10				institution of higher education in this state and maintains a cumulative grade	
11				point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 grading scale.	
12	2.	The	e state	e board shall monitor each scholarship recipient to ensure that the student	
13		mee	ets the	e academic and other requirements of this section. Upon determining that a	
14		reci	pient	student has failed to meet the requirements of this section, the board shall	
15		prov	vide r	otification to the student within ten days.

17			thar	n six thousand dollars under this section.	
18		<u>b.</u>	<u>A st</u>	udent who graduates from high school during or after the 2014-15 school	
19			yea	r is entitled to receive up to eight thousand dollars under this section.

21		inst	itutior	n in which the student is enrolled.	
22	5.	a.	(1)	This section does not require a student to be enrolled in consecutive	
23				semesters.	
24			(2)	This section does not require a student to be enrolled in consecutive	
25				quarters.	
26		b.	Hov	vever, a scholarship under this section is valid only for six academic years	
27			afte	r the student's graduation from high school and may not be applied to	
28			grad	duate programs.	
29	6.	As	A scholarship under this section is available to any eligible resident student who fulfills		
30		the	the requirements of section 15.1-21-02.4 or 15.1-21-02.5 and who:

6	7.	a.	For	purposes of North Dakota scholarship eligibility under this section, "full-time"	
7			mea	ans enrollment in at least twelve credits during a student's first two semesters	
8			and	enrollment in at least fifteen credits during each semester thereafter or	
9			enro	ollment in the equivalent number of credits, as determined by the state board	
10			of h	igher education, with respect to students in a quarter system.	
11		b.	(1)	If a student requires fewer than fifteen credits to graduate, the student may	
12				retain scholarship eligibility by enrolling in fewer than fifteen but at least	
13				twelve credits during the semester, or the equivalent number of credits, as	
14				determined by the state board of higher education, with respect to students	
15				in a quarter system.	
16			(2)	Students who graduated from high school during the 2009-10 or the	
17				2010-11 school year and who have completed six semesters may retain	
18				scholarship eligibility by enrolling in only twelve credits during each of the	
19				student's final two semesters, or the equivalent number of credits, as	
20				determined by the state board of higher education, with respect to students	
21				in a quarter system.	
22			(3)	The requirement that a student be enrolled in at least fifteen credits, as set	
23				forth in subdivision a, does not apply in the case of a student participating in	
24				a clinical, practicum, internship, cooperative program, or similar external	
25				experience, provided the external experience is equivalent to at least twelve	
26				units, or such similar amount as determined by the state board of higher	
27				education, with respect to students in a quarter system, and considered to	
28				be a "full time" placement for purposes of meeting graduation requirements.	
29	SE	стю	N 4. A	APPROPRIATION - STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - STUDENT	
30	FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM. There is appropriated out of any moneys in				
31	the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$30,690,000, or				

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- 1 so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the
- 2 purpose of awarding grants under the student financial assistance program, for the biennium
- 3 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

4 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - NORTH

DAKOTA SCHOLARSHIPS. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the
state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$17,426,748, or so much of the sum as
may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of providing academic
and career and technical education scholarships, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and

9 ending June 30, 2017.
