- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of
- 2 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to motor vehicle registration fees for current and
- 3 former national guard members; and to provide a contingent effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 39-04-18 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

One motor vehicle not exceeding twenty-six thousand pounds [11793.40-kilograms] registered gross weight owned and operated by a resident who is a current or retired national guard member. A passenger motor vehicle, house car, or pickup truck not exceeding ten thousand pounds [4535.92 kilograms] registered gross weight and which is owned and operated by a resident who is serving as a member of or is a retired member of the North Dakota national guard is entitled to display a national guard license plate issued by the department upon the payment of a fee of five dollars. This exemption applies to no more than one license plate for each national guard member or retired member at any one time.

SECTION 2. CONTINGENT EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective on the date the director of the department of transportation certifies to the secretary of state that the new motor vehicle registration software for the department is installed and functioning and not earlier than January 1, 2016.
