- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 6 and 55 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to reduced hunting and fishing license fees for resident current
- 3 and retired national guard members.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsections 6 and 55 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North
  Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 6. For a resident fishing license, sixteen dollars, except that for a resident sixty-five years or over, a resident totally or permanently disabled, or a resident disabled veteran who has a fifty percent service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the veteran's total disability ratio to fifty percent, or a resident who is a current or retired national guard member, the license fee is five dollars.
- For a resident disabled veteran <u>or a resident who is a current or retired national guard</u>
  member, combined general game, habitat stamp, small game, and fur-bearer license,
  three dollars.
