- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a report to the legislative management regarding medical
- 2 psychologist licensure; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AND HEALTH SCIENCES ADVISORY COUNCIL -

5 STUDY OF MEDICAL PSYCHOLOGIST LICENSURE - REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE

6 **MANAGEMENT.** During the 2015-16 interim, the university of North Dakota school of medicine 7 and health sciences advisory council shall use the resources of the university of North Dakota 8 school of medicine and health sciences center for rural health to study the feasibility and 9 desirability of licensing medical psychologists. The study must include evaluation of whether 10 licensure of medical psychologists would integrate behavioral health into primary care and 11 whether the practice of medical psychology would result in safe and effective treatment of 12 patients with behavioral health concerns. If the school of medicine and health sciences advisory 13 council determines it is feasible and desirable to license medical psychologists in this state, the 14 study must include consideration of licensure requirements, scope of practice, which licensure 15 board would be best suited to license medical psychologists, and terminology. Before July 1, 16 2016, the school of medicine and health sciences advisory council shall report the outcome of 17 the study, recommendations, and related proposed legislation to a legislative management 18 committee charged with studying human services-related topics.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the university of North Dakota school of medicine and health sciences for the purpose of conducting the study under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
