## **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2271**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 4-01-31 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a pipeline restoration and reclamation oversight program; to provide an appropriation;
- 3 and to declare an emergency.

#### 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 4-01-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as 6 follows:

## 4-01-31. Pipeline restoration and reclamation oversight pilot program - Generally.

- 1. The agriculture commissioner shall establish a pilot program that shall provide
  technical assistance and support to surface owners and surface tenants on pipeline
  restoration and followup support to surface owners and surface tenants on pipeline
- 11 <u>reclamation.</u>

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- 16 assist in easement negotiations.
- The pilot program may provide technical education, support, and outreach on
  pipeline-related matters in coordination with other entities.
- 4. The agriculture commissioner may contract with local individuals, deemed trustworthy
  by the surface owners and surface tenants, to be ombudsmen. The agriculture
  commissioner is not subject to the provisions of chapter 54-44.4 when contracting for
- the services of ombudsmen.

**SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general abandoned oil and gas well plugging site reclamation fund in the state treasury, not

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- 1 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$660,000\$400,000, or so much of the sum as may be
- 2 necessary, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of establishing and administering a
- 3 pipeline restoration and reclamation oversight pilot program, without additional full-time
- 4 employees, under this section 1 of this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending
- 5 June 30, 2017.
- 6 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
