- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 4-01-31 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to a pipeline restoration and reclamation oversight program; to provide an appropriation;
- 3 and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Section 4-01-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as
 follows:
 <u>4-01-31. Pipeline restoration and reclamation oversight pilot program - Generally.</u>
 <u>1.</u> The agriculture commissioner shall establish a pilot program that shall provide.

- 10 restoration and followup support to surface owners and surface tenants on pipeline
- 11 <u>reclamation.</u>
- 12 <u>2.</u> <u>The agriculture commissioner may contract or employ</u>for ombudsmen for the purposes
- 13 of being a resource for technical assistance and followup on pipeline issues. The
- 14 <u>ombudsmen may not investigate or assist with any pipeline installed before January 1,</u>
- 15 2006, or regulated by the public service commission under title 49, or and may not
- 16 <u>assist in easement negotiations.</u>
- 17 <u>3.</u> <u>The pilot program may provide technical education, support, and outreach on</u>
 18 <u>pipeline-related matters in coordination with other entities.</u>
- 194.The agriculture commissioner may contract with local individuals, deemed trustworthy20by the surface owners and surface tenants, to be ombudsmen. The agriculture
- 21 commissioner is not subject to the provisions of chapter 54-44.4 when contracting for
 22 the services of ombudsmen.
- 23 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
- 24 generalabandoned oil and gas well plugging site reclamation fund in the state treasury, not

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- 1 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$660,000<u>\$400,000</u>, or so much of the sum as may be
- 2 necessary, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of establishing and administering a
- 3 pipeline restoration and reclamation oversight pilot program, without additional full-time
- 4 <u>employees</u>, under this section <u>1 of this Act</u>, for the biennium beginning July <u>1</u>, <u>2015</u>period
- 5 beginning with the effective date of this Act, and ending June 30, 2017.
- 6 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
