- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 54-06-14.5 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to use of state employee sick leave for birth or adoption of a child.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- **SECTION 1.** Section 54-06-14.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>54-06-14.5. Sick leave for birth or adoption of child.</u>
- 7 <u>1. During the first twelve months following birth or placement, an employer shall grant an</u>
- 8 <u>employee's request to use sick leave under section 54-06-14 to care for the</u>
- 9 employee's newborn child or to care for a child placed with the employee, by a
- 10 <u>child-placing agency licensed under chapter 50-12, for adoption or placed with the</u>
- employee as a precondition to adoption under section 14-15-12, but not both.
- 12 <u>2. In the case of an adoption or a placement as a precondition to adoption, the use of</u>
- sick leave under this section is limited to the first twelve months of the child living in
- the employee's home. During any twelve-month period, an employee may not use
- more than six weeks of sick leave under this section and the sick leave must conclude
- within the first twelve months following birth or placement.
- 17 <u>3. The sick leave required by this section supplements any leave otherwise available to</u>
- 18 <u>an employee.</u>
