3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:							
4	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-21-02.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is

7	Any resident student who graduates from a high school during or after the 2010-11 school							
8	year and any resident student who completes a program of home education supervised in							
9	accordance with chapter 15.1-23 during or after the 2012-13 school year is eligible to receive a							
10	North Dakota career and technical education scholarship provided the student:							
11	1.	Completed four units of English language arts from a sequence that includes literature,						
12		con	nposition, and speech;					
13	2.	Cor	mpleted three units of mathematics, including:					
14		a.	One unit of algebra II, as defined by the superintendent of public instruction; and					
15		b.	Two units of any other mathematics;					
16	3. Completed three units of science, including:		npleted three units of science, including:					
17		a.	One unit of physical science;					
18		b.	One unit of biology; and					
19		C.	(1) One unit of any other science; or					

Two one-half units of any other science;
