- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of a medication therapy management program for
- 3 medicaid-eligible individuals; and to provide an effective date.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 50-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

## 7 <u>Medication therapy management program.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>The department shall establish a medication therapy management program available</u>
- 9 <u>to medicaid-eligible individuals in the medical and hospital benefits coverage group.</u>
- 10 <u>The purpose of the medication therapy management program is to coordinate health</u>
- 11 <u>care and improve the health of individuals in the identified health populations and to</u>
- 12 <u>manage health care expenditures.</u>
- 13 <u>2.</u> <u>The department may involve physicians, pharmacists, and other health professionals</u>
   in the program. Any physicians, pharmacists, and other health professionals who
- 15 provide face-to-face or telephonic medication therapy management services to

16 <u>covered individuals in the identified health population are entitled to reimbursement.</u>

- 17 <u>3.</u> <u>The department may request the assistance of the North Dakota pharmacists</u>
- 18 association or a specified delegate to implement a formalized medication therapy
- 19 program. This program must facilitate enrollment procedures, provide standards of
- 20 <u>care, enable consistent documentation of clinical and economic outcomes, and</u>
- 21 <u>structure an outcomes reporting system.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on January 1, 2016.
