4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY -
CONSTRUCTION OF GOVERNOR'S RESIDENCE. There is appropriated out of any moneys in
the capitol building fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of
\$5,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the office of management and
budget for the purpose of During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall study the
options for constructing a governor's residence, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and
ending June 30, 2017. The office of management and budget shall use the funds appropriated
in this section forstudy must consider the demolition of the current governor's residence and for
the design and construction of a new governor's residence on the site of the current residence.
The office of management and budget may not expend any funds appropriated under this-
section for demolition or construction until after January 1, 2017 The legislative management
shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to
implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly.
