- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 10-06.1-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the ownership or leasing of farm and ranch land by corporations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** Section 10-06.1-12.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>10-06.1-12.1. Ownership or leasing of land by corporations Exceptions.</u>
- This chapter does not apply to the ownership or leasing of land used for the operation
 of a dairy farm by a domestic corporation or a limited liability company and does not
 prohibit the operation of a dairy farm by a domestic corporation or a limited liability
 company, provided:
- 11 <u>a. The land owned or leased for the authorized purpose does not exceed six</u>

 12 <u>hundred forty acres [258.99 hectares];</u>
- 13 <u>b.</u> The dairy farm is operational within three years from the date the land is
 14 <u>acquired; and</u>
 - c. The dairy farm is permitted as an animal feeding operation or as a concentrated animal feeding operation by the state department of health and consists of at least fifty cows.
 - 2. This chapter does not apply to the ownership or leasing of land used for the operation of a swine production facility by a domestic corporation or a limited liability company and does not prohibit the operation of a swine production facility by a domestic corporation or a limited liability company, provided:
 - a. The land owned or leased for the authorized purpose does not exceed six hundred forty acres [258.99 hectares];

1 The swine production facility is operational within three years from the date the 2 land is acquired; and 3 <u>C.</u> The swine production facility is permitted as an animal feeding operation or as a 4 concentrated animal feeding operation by the state department of health and 5 consists of at least five hundred swine. 6 The agriculture commissioner shall by rule develop reporting and monitoring <u>3.</u> 7 requirements to ensure compliance with this section. 8 <u>4.</u> If the agriculture commissioner determines that a domestic corporation or a 9 limited liability company is not operating within the exceptions provided by this 10 section, the commissioner shall notify the secretary of state and the attorney 11 general. 12 A domestic corporation or a limited liability company that is not operating within <u>b.</u> 13 the exceptions provided by this section is subject to the enforcement provisions 14 of this chapter.
