- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of oil and gas and abandoned
- 2 gravel pit reclamation practices.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - RECLAMATION PRACTICES.

- 5 During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall study oil and gas and
- 6 abandoned gravel pit reclamation practices. The study must include the consideration of
- 7 feasibility and desirability of utilizing state funds for the reclamation of oil and gas
- 8 development-impacted areas and abandoned gravel pits, natural erosion events, and financially
- 9 difficult reclamation projects for the purpose of restoring land for farming, ranching, or clean
- water initiatives. The study shall emphasize consideration of the potential economic benefit of
- 11 restored or repurposed land.
- The study shall include consideration of current reclamation practices and standards for all
- 13 North Dakota industries; use of the North Dakota outdoor heritage fund or other funds for
- 14 financing; and input from departments, organizations, and associations with interest in
- 15 reclamation practices.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with
- 17 any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative
- 18 assembly.
