1 A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 5 of article IV of the Constitution of North 2 Dakota, relating to residency requirements of members of the legislative assembly. 3 STATEMENT OF INTENT 4 This measure would require a member of the legislative assembly to be a resident of the district 5 from which selected. 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF 7 REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 8 That the following proposed amendment to section 5 of article IV of the Constitution of 9 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the 10 primary election to be held in 2016, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the 11 Constitution of North Dakota. 12 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 5 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota is 13 amended and reenacted as follows: 14 Section 5. Each person elected to member of the legislative assembly must be, on the day-15 of the election, a qualified elector in the district from which the member was chosen and must

have been a resident of the state for one year immediately prior to that election selection to the
