1 A concurrent resolution urging the Department of Transportation to use dynamic message signs 2 solely for weather-related, road condition, emergency, work zone, and missing persons 3 messages. 4 WHEREAS, dynamic message signs provide information to the motoring public through an 5 electronic display; and 6 WHEREAS, messages on these signs may be changed depending on the circumstances; 7 and 8 WHEREAS, this state has 30 portable dynamic message signs, which are used primarily for 9 work zones, and 30 permanent dynamic message signs; and 10 WHEREAS, using the signs for messages that are not necessary contradicts other 11 regulations of signs which provide for the beautification of the highway system; and 12 WHEREAS, displaying unnecessary messages creates a distraction to the driver when the 13 the Department of Transportation should be promoting nondistracted driving; and 14 WHEREAS, these signs can be obtrusive, distracting, and Orwellian when not used with 15 proper discretion; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 17 18 That the Sixty-fourth Legislative Assembly urges the Department of Transportation to use 19 dynamic message signs solely for weather-related, road condition, emergency, work zone, and 20 missing persons messages; and 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward a copy of this resolution

to the Director of the Department of Transportation.
