1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study American Indian student
2	support and service programs at all institutions of higher education in the state, including
3	recruitment and retention efforts, admissions standards, ancillary programs, cultural sensitivity
4	training, financial aid programs, and all current funding and support providing services to
5	American Indian students.
6	WHEREAS, the North Dakota University System and its affiliated schools have long strived
7	to meet the unique needs of our American Indian students; and
8	WHEREAS, American Indian students represent the largest minority group attending North
9	Dakota institutions of higher education but are still largely unrepresented on our campuses; and
10	WHEREAS, the programs intended to provide support and services for American Indian
11	students are inconsistent in focus and funding across the eleven public campuses; and
12	WHEREAS, the cultural diversity tuition waiver program has seen drastic changes in intent
13	and has seen no increase in the number of awards granted since its inception; and
14	WHEREAS, recruitment efforts directed at American Indian students could be expanded to
15	include Alaska and other areas with significant populations of American Indians; and
16	WHEREAS, our public campuses could greatly benefit from increased cultural sensitivity
17	training to increase exposure to all diverse populations in our state and region;
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
19	NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
20	That the Legislative Management study American Indian student support and service
21	programs at all institutions of higher education in the state, including recruitment and retention
22	efforts, admissions standards, ancillary programs, cultural sensitivity training, financial aid
23	programs, and all current funding and support providing services to American Indian students;
