- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 29-28-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to appeals by the state.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 29-28-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **29-28-07. From what the state may appeal.**

- 7 An appeal may be taken by the state from:
- 8 1. An order quashing an information or indictment or any count thereof.
- 9 2. An order granting a new trial.
- 10 3. An order arresting judgment.
- 11 4. An order made after judgment affecting any substantial right of the state.
- 12 5. An order granting the return of property or suppressing evidence, or suppressing a
- 13 confession or admission, when accompanied by a statement of the prosecuting
- 14 attorney asserting that the appeal is not taken for purpose of delay and that the
- 15 evidence is a substantial proof of a fact material in the proceeding. The statement
- must be filed with the clerk of district court and a copy must accompany the notice of
 appeal.
