- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol;
- 2 to provide for a transfer; to provide for legislative intent; and to provide for expense payments to
- 3 highway patrol officers.

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4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

22	2017-19 biennium. The highway patrol shall report to the appropriations committees of the					
23	sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning					
24	July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.					
25	SECTION 3. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER. The less estimated income line item in					
26	section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,606,826\$6,752,491, or so much of the sum as may					
27	be necessary, from the state highway tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the					
28	direction of the superintendent of the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses					
29	of the highway patrol during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.					
30	SECTION 4. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS. Each patrol officer of the					

highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an amount

- 1 not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30,
- 2 2017. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other expenses, except
- 3 lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at their respective home
- 4 stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the same manner as salaries are paid to
- 5 members of the highway patrol and may be paid without the presentation of receipts or other
- 6 memorandums.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. It is the intent of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly that the information technology department be responsible for the oversight of the installation of any radio communications equipment by an executive branch state agency.
