- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the agriculture
- 2 commissioner; to amend and reenact section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,

3 relating to the salary of the agriculture commissioner; and to provide for transfers.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 8 other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that 9 agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

15	environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund during the biennium				
16	beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.				
17	SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION				
18	FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,403,714,				
19	or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and rangeland protection				
20	fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department of agriculture programs,				
21	for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.				
22	SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND. The estimated income line				
23	item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$499,585, or so much of the sum as may be				
24	necessary, from the game and fish department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the				
25	expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1,				
26	2015, and ending June 30, 2017.				
27	SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE WATER COMMISSION - TRANSFER. The				
28	estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000 which the state				
29	water commission shall transfer to the agriculture commissioner for the wildlife services				
30	program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

1 SECTION 7. WATERBANK PROGRAM - MATCHING FUNDS. The salaries and wages line

- 4 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended
- 5 and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **4-01-21. Salary of agriculture commissioner.**
- 7 The annual salary of the agriculture commissioner is ninety-nine thousand four hundred-
- 8 thirty-five dollars through June 30, 2014, and one hundred two thousand four hundred
- 9 eighteenone hundred five thousand four hundred ninety-one dollars through June 30, 2016, and
- 10 <u>one hundred eight thousand six hundred fifty-six</u> dollars thereafter.
