## FIRST ENGROSSMENT with House Amendments ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2017

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the game and fish
- 2 department; to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-08 of the North Dakota Century
- 3 Code, relating to a gubernatorial proclamation concerning the hunting of elk; to provide for a
- 4 legislative management study; and to provide an expiration date.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the game and fish department for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the game and fish department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

15	apply; however, the governor may by proclamation make available to Annie's house at				
16	Bottineau winter park a license to hunt elk in a manner, places, and times as the governor				
17	prescribes. Annie's house at Bottineau winter park shall hold a raffle under rules adopted by the				
18	director with residents and nonresidents eligible to participate. No more than ten percent of the				
19	gross proceeds of the raffle may be used	d to promote the raff	le and all remaining	net proceeds	
20	nust be used to support the operations of Annie's house at Bottineau winter park. Annie's
