HB 1262 creates a renters refund program for disabled veterans.

HB 1262 creates a companion renter's refund program to the disabled veterans property tax credit program. It enables qualifying disabled veterans who rent their homes to qualify for a refund of a portion of their rent, up to a maximum refund of \$400. Like the property tax program, this renters program requires a service-related disability of 50% or greater.

If enacted, HB 1262 will increase state general fund expenditures for the disabled veterans property tax credit and renters refund programs by an estimated \$2.02 million for the 2015-17 biennium.

If enacted, HB 1262 will require an increase in the Tax Department appropriation for the disabled veterans property tax credit and renters refund program, estimated at \$2.02 million for the 2015-17 biennium.

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
