1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 44-04-18.15 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2 relating to exempting donor records from public disclosure under open records laws.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 44-04-18.15 of the North Dakota Century Code is
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **~~44-04-18.15. Fundraising and donor records of board of higher education, university-~~**
7 **~~system, and affiliated nonprofit organizations exempt.~~**

8 1. Any private donor or prospective donor name, address, telephone number, electronic
9 mail address, estate planning information, tax record or financial information, or other
10 personal information or correspondence received or retained by a board of higher
11 education or university system officer or employee or by an affiliated nonprofit
12 organization that provides support to and is organized and operated for the benefit of
13 an institution under the authority of the board of higher education is exempt.

14 2. Any private donor or prospective donor name, address, telephone number, electronic
15 mail address, estate planning information, tax record or financial information, or other
16 personal information or correspondence received or retained by a nonprofit
17 organization that is a public entity is exempt.

18 3. For the purposes of this section, "financial information" includes data that provides
19 details regarding a gift, a payment schedule of a gift, the form of a gift, or the specific
20 amount of a gift made by a donor.
