(Higher Education Committee)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-10-38 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the teacher shortage loan forgiveness program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15-10-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15-10-38. Loans Teacher shortages Loan forgiveness.
- The state board of higher education shall administer a student loan forgiveness
 program for individuals teaching at grade levels or in content areas identified as
 having a teacher shortage. The board shall adopt rules to implement the program.
 - 2. The superintendent of public instruction shall annually identify the grade levels and content areas in which a teacher shortage exists.
 - 3. To be eligible for loan forgiveness under this section, an individual:
- a. Must have been admitted as a full-time student in a teacher preparation program,
 with the declared intention hold qualifying qualified license, endorsements or
 credentials to teach at a grade level or in a content area identified by the
 superintendent of public instruction as one in which a teacher shortage exists;
 and
 - b. Must have obtained a student loan with the Bank of North Dakota or other participating lender; and
 - c. Must hold a current North Dakota educator's license.
- 4. An individual may receive up to one thousand <u>five hundred</u> dollars per year and a maximum of <u>fivesix</u> thousand dollars, or a lesser amount established by rule adopted by the state board of higher education under this section.
 - 5. The board shall consider all applications under this section in chronological order.

- 1 6. Upon notification that the individual has completed <u>or will complete</u> a full year of
 2 teaching in a school district or nonpublic school in this state at a grade level or in a
 3 content area identified by the superintendent of public instruction as one in which a
 4 teacher shortage exists, the board shall distribute funds directly to the Bank of North
 5 Dakota <u>or other participating lender</u> to repay outstanding loan principal balances for
 6 eligible applicants.
 - 7. An individual may not receive a loan forgiveness award under this section if the individual is receiving a loan forgiveness award under section 15-10-37 during the same application year.
