A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-04-10.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to personalized plates; to provide for application; and to provide an effective date.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-04-10.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

## 39-04-10.3. Personalized plates.

1. At the request of a registrant, the department may provide special license plates marked with not more than seven numerals, letters, or ampersands, or combinations of numerals, letters, and ampersands, upon application for a special license plate and payment of an additional fee of twenty-five dollars per registration period, unless the plate is a gold star license plate or a prisoner of war license plate, then there is no additional charge.
2. The fee for a requested special license plate marked with a combination of numerals, letters, or ampersands identical to a registrant's previously issued nonspecialized license plate is a one-time fee of one hundred dollars. A special license plate issued under this subsection is exempt from the additional fee of twenty-five dollars per registration period.
3. The department shall make the special license plates authorized by this section available for motor vehicles registered under section 39-04-10.6, trailers, travel trailers, and motorcycles. The fee for the special license plates issued under this section for vehicles registered under section 39-04-10.6 is a one-time fee of one hundred dollars. The special license plates for motorcycles may contain not more than six numerals, letters, or ampersands, or a combination of not more than six numerals, letters, and ampersands.
4. In the event of sale or transfer of the vehicle, the owner must remove the special license plates in accordance with section 39-04-36. Upon payment of the applicable transfer fee, the special license plates may be transferred to a replacement motor vehicle.

SECTION 2. APPLICATION. The department of transportation shall reduce the one-time fee of one hundred dollars under section 1 of this Act by any additional specialized plate fee of twenty-five dollars per registration period which has been paid by a registrant in 2016 and 2017.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act becomes effective on January 1, 2018.
