1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance

- 2 commissioner; to provide an appropriation for the distribution of funds from the insurance tax
- 3 distribution fund; to provide a transfer; and to amend and reenact section 18-04-05 of the North
- 4 Dakota Century Code, relating to payments to fire departments from the insurance tax
- 5 distribution fund.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds and other
income, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
insurance commissioner, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019,
as follows:

SECTION 2. HEALTH INSURANCE INCREASE. The salaries and wages line item in
section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$124,767 from other funds for increases in employee
health insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,241 per month.

3	SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance		
4	tax distribution fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$15,064,086 or		
5	so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of		
6	providing payments, in accordance with provisions of section 18-04-05, to North Dakota fire		
7	departments in the amount of \$14,235,561 and payments to the North Dakota firefighter's		
8	association in the amount of \$828,525 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending		
9	June 30, 2019.		
10	SECTION 5. BONDING FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes \$52,004 from the state		e
11	bonding fund to pay bonding fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1,		July 1,
12	2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
13	SECTION 6. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND.	Section 1 of this Act includes \$1,797,2	18 from

25	insurance tax distribution fund continued into the 2017-19 biennium pursuant to section 7 of		7 of
26	chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws, must be transferred to the general fund on August 1,		st 1,

28	SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 18-04-	05 of the North Dakota Century Code	is

29 amended and reenacted as follows:

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1	18-0	04-05. Amount due cities, rural fire protection districts, or rural fire departments -	
2	Transfer to firefighters death benefit fund - Disbursement to North Dakota firefighter's		
3	associa	tion - Payments by insurance commissioner.	
4	1.	The insurance commissioner shall disburse funds in the insurance tax distribution fund	
5		as provided under this section.	
6	2.	The insurance commissioner shall transfer an amount of up to fifty thousand dollars	
7		per biennium, as may be necessary, to the firefighters death benefit fund for	
8		distribution under chapter 18-05.1.	
9	3.	The insurance commissioner shall disburse funds to the North Dakota firefighter's	
10		association for uses authorized under chapter 18-03, subject to legislative	
11		appropriations.	
12	4.	The insurance commissioner shall compute the amounts due to the certified city fire	
13		departments, certified rural fire departments, or certified fire protection districts entitled	
14		to benefits under this chapter on or before December first of each year. The insurance	
15		commissioner shall allocate one-half of the biennial legislative appropriation which-	
16		must be based on an amount equal to one hundred percent of the total premium tax-	
17		collected for fire, allied lines, homeowner's multiple peril, farmowner's multiple peril,	
18		commercial multiple peril, and crop hail insurance, less the amount transferred to the	
19		firefighters death benefit fund and the amount distributed to the North Dakota	
20		firefighter's association for distribution under this subsection, to each eligible city not	
21		within a certified fire protection district, each certified rural fire protection district	
22		organized under this title, and each rural fire department certified by the state fire	
23		marshal, and pay the amount allocated in December of each year. The allocation must	
24		be made in proportion to the amount of insurance company premiums received by	
25		insurance companies pursuant to section 26.1-03-17 for policies for fire, allied lines,	
26		homeowner's multiple peril, farmowner's multiple peril, commercial multiple peril, and	
27		crop hail insurance on property within the city, certified rural fire protection district, or	
28		area served by the certified rural fire department to the total of those premiums for	
29		those policies in the state.
