1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the department of

2 financial institutions; to provide for a study; and to provide for a report to the legislative

3 management.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 6 as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from other income, to the 7 department of financial institutions for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the department 8 of financial institutions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as 9 follows:
