1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state fair

2 association; to create and enact a new section to chapter 4-02.1 of the North Dakota Century

3 Code, relating to facility operations or maintenance costs on the state fairgrounds; and to

4 provide a statement of legislative intent.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state fair association for the purpose of defraying 9 the expenses of the state fair association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending 10 June 30, 2019, as follows:

20 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - PREMIUMS. It is the intent of the sixty-fifth

21 legislative assembly that the state fair association use \$17,000 of its available operating funds

to supplement funding for premiums appropriated in section 1 of this Act for the biennium

- 5 the cost of any of its facility operations or maintenance costs from the state general fund.
