## **ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2011**

**Appropriations Committee** 

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the highway patrol:
- 2 to create and enact two new sections to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to capitol building access cards and job shadowing with the highway patrol; to amend
- 4 and reenact subdivision j of subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 of the North Dakota Century
- 5 Code, relating to fees for electronic permits; to provide a continuing appropriation; and to
- 6 provide for a transfer.

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## 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway patrol, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

3	SECTION 2. HEALTH INSURANCE INCREASE. Section 1 of this Act includes the sum of				
4	\$533,578, of which \$426,619 is from the general fund, for increases in employee health				
5	insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,241 per month.				
6	SECTION 3. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO				
7	SIXTY-SIXTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding				
8	items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly as adjusted for the 2015-17 biennium				
9	and the 2017-19 biennium one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of

24	SECTION 4. SPECIAL FUNDS TRANSFER - HIGHWAY TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND. The				
25	less estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of				
26	\$6,916,962\$6,912,904, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the state highway				
27	tax distribution fund which may be transferred at the direction of the superintendent of the				
28	highway patrol for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the highway patrol during the				
29	biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.				
30	SECTION 5. MOTOR CARRIER	ELECTRONIC PERMIT	TRANSACTION F	FUND. The	

estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$1,269,165 from the motor carrier

1	electronic permit transaction fund for the purpose of defraying various expenses associated with		
2	the issuance of permits during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
3	SECTION 6. STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND. The estimated		
4	income line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$358,000 of one-time funding from the strategic		
5	investment and improvements fund for equipment replacement during the biennium beginning		
6	July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.		
7	SECTION 7. PAYMENTS TO HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS. Each patrol officer of the		
8	state highway patrol is entitled to receive from funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act an		
9	amount not to exceed \$200 per month for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and		
10	ending June 30, 2019. The payments are in lieu of reimbursement for meals and other		
11	expenses, except lodging, while in travel status within the state of North Dakota or while at the		
12	patrol officers' respective home stations. The amounts must be paid at the time and in the		
13	same manner as salaries are paid to members of the highway patrol and may be paid without		
14	the presentation of receipts or other memorandums.		
15	SECTION 8. A new section to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created		
16	and enacted as follows:		
17	Capitol building access card fund - Continuing appropriation.		
18	There is created in the state treasury a capitol building access card fund. The fund consists		
19	of any fees received by the superintendent for the issuance of capitol building access cards.		
20	The superintendent shall establish policies regarding the issuance of capitol building access		
21	cards and may charge a fee of ten dollars for each access card issued to an individual who is		
22	not an employee of the state of North Dakota. All moneys in the fund are appropriated to the		
23	highway patrol on a continuing basis for costs associated with the issuance of capitol building		
24	access cards and capitol complex security needs.		
25	SECTION 9. A new section to chapter 39-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created		
26	and enacted as follows:		
27	Job shadowing.		
28	For purposes of education and community outreach and to promote public trust, the		
29	superintendent may permit a non-member of the highway patrol to participate in job shadowing		
30	activities, including:		

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- 1. Participating in a ride-along program with a member of the highway patrol while on duty:
- Operating a highway patrol motor vehicle on a closed course under the supervision of a member of the highway patrol; and
- 3. Discharging a firearm owned and used by the highway patrol while at a training facility and under supervision of a member of the highway patrol.

**SECTION 10. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision j of subsection 3 of section 39-12-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

j. The highway patrol may establish an online electronic permit system. If the highway patrol establishes an online electronic permit system, the highway patrol shall assess an additional fee of up to fifteen dollar feedollars for every permit issued under this section to be deposited into the motor carrier electronic permit transaction fund.
