1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 39-12-05.3 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to weight limitations and the movement of agricultural products during-

3 harvestfor vehicles on highways other than the interstate system.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 39-12-05.3 of the North Dakota

6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7	4. <u>a.</u> The director, and local authorities, as to the highways under their respective
8	jurisdictions, may issue permits authorizing a specific motor vehicle:
9	(1) A farmer's farm vehicle or a motor carrier hired by a farmer to exceed the
10	weight limitations stated in subsections 1 and 2 by ten percent. The permits
11	may not provide for a gross weight in excess of one hundred five thousand
12	five hundred pounds [47854.00 kilograms]. The permits must provide only
13	for the movement of agricultural products from:
14	(a) From the field of harvest to the point of initial storage site or to the first
15	point of sale and transfer of possession during harvest , and for the ; or
16	(b) From the point of initial storage to the first point of sale and transfer of
17	possession during the current year's harvest; or
18	(2) A specific motor vehicle to exceed the weight limitations stated in
19	subsections 1 and 2 by ten percent. The permits may not provide for a gross
20	weight in excess of one hundred five thousand five hundred pounds [47854
21	kilograms]. The permits must provide only for the collection and transport of
22	solid wastes, during the period from July fifteenth to December first, and for
23	the general movement of products during the period from December first to
24	March seventh.

b.The appropriate jurisdictional authority shall establish an appropriate fee for thepermits and direct how they shall be issued. The highway patrol shall issue thepermits authorized by the director.
