- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new chapter to title 23 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to a cardiac ready community grant program; and to provide a continuing
- 3 appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new chapter to title 23 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and
6 enacted as follows:

7 Cardiac ready community grant program.

8 The state department of health shall establish a cardiac ready community grant program.

9 The primary purpose of the program is to support bystander, emergency responder, and

10 <u>community private public partnerships for strengthening community-based capacity for cardiac</u>

11 and stroke emergency response and risk reduction programs throughout the state. The program

12 must build on and may not duplicate existing programs. The department shall award grants on a

13 competitive basis based on criteria established by an advisory committee. To facilitate volume

14 purchasing savings, the department may procure vendor rates and purchases, and grant the

15 acquired elements to community programs.

16 <u>Cardiac ready community grant program advisory committee - Duties.</u>

- 17 <u>1.</u> <u>The state department of health shall establish a cardiac ready community grant</u>
- 18 program advisory committee with members appointed by the state health officer. The
- 19 advisory committee shall advise the department in the development of the cardiac
- 20 ready community grant program and the membership must include a representative of
- 21 the department, one cardiac ready community member, one representative of the
- 22 <u>emergency medical services association, one representative of the American heart</u>
- 23 association, one representative of the cardiac task force, one representative of the
- 24 <u>stroke task force, one representative of the emergency services advisory committee,</u>
