A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-38-29.3 of the North Dakota Century Code,
relating to an income tax credit for premiums for hybrid long-term care partnership plan
insurance coverage; and to provide an effective date for an Act to provide for a legislative
management study of providing an income tax credit for premiums for hybrid long-term care
partnership plan insurance coverage.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 57-38-29.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 57-38-29.3. Credit for premiums for long-term care partnership plan insurance coverage.
 A credit against an individual's tax liability under this chapter is provided to each taxpayer in

- A credit against an individual's tax liability under this chapter is provided to each taxpayer in the amount of the premiums paid during the taxable year by the taxpayer for qualified long-term care partnership plan insurance coverage, or for long-term care insurance coverage that is part of a hybrid long-term care insurance policy as provided for under section 844(b) of the Pension Protection Act of 2006 [Pub. L. 109-280; 25 U.S.C. 1035], for the taxpayer or the taxpayer's spouse, or both. The credit under this section for each insured individual may not exceed two-hundred fifty dollars in any taxable year. For purposes of this section, "qualified long-term care partnership plan" is one that:
 - 1. Is a qualified long-term care insurance policy, as defined in section 7702B(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, with an issue date on or after the date specified in an approved medicaid state plan amendment that provides for the disregard of assets;
 - 2. Meets the requirements of the long-term care insurance model regulations and the long-term care insurance model act promulgated by the national association of
