- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subsection to section 54-11-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to duties of the state treasurer; to amend and reenact section 10-15-49
- 3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to abandoned property; and to repeal section
- 4 15-02-05.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the administrator of abandoned
- 5 property.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 10-15-49 of the North Dakota Century Code is
  amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 10-15-49. Amounts due unknown persons.
  - Upon liquidation of a cooperative, the assets distributable to persons who are unknown or cannot be found may be reduced to cash and transferred to the <del>commissioner of university and school lands</del> administrator of unclaimed property and <del>shall</del> shall be treated as abandoned and unclaimed property under the escheat and abandoned property laws of the state.
- SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 54-11-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Shall employ an administrator of abandoned property and other personnel as
- 17 <u>necessary for the proper administration of chapter 47-30.1 and shall set the salaries.</u>
- within limits of legislative appropriations. All public officers shall assist the
- administrator in carrying out the administration of chapter 47-30.1.
- **SECTION 3. REPEAL.** Section 15-02-05.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
