- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 40-08-09 and 40-09-17 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to employing as city employees members of city council or city
- 3 commission.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 40-08-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 7 **40-08-09.** Restrictions on members of council.

- 8 1. Except as provided in <del>subsection 2<u>this section</u>, no member of the city council shall:</del>
- 9a.Be eligible to any other office the salary of which is payable out of the city10treasury;
- b. Hold any other office under the city government; or
- 12 c. Hold a position of remuneration in the employment of the city.
- A member of the city council may serve as an ambulance crew member employed by
  the city or under a contract with the city and be remunerated for those services or as a
  volunteer firefighter or ambulance crew member for the city and be compensated for
  attending training or responding to emergency calls or may be reimbursed for
- 17 expenses incurred in attending training or in responding to emergency calls.
- 18 <u>3.</u> <u>A member of the city council in a city having a population of five hundred or fewer may</u>
- 19 hold a position of remuneration in the employment of the city if no other qualified
- 20 individual is available to hold the position of remuneration at an equal cost to the city.
- 21 The decision to employ the member of the city council must receive the unanimous
- 22 approval of the other members of the council, and the approval must be documented
- 23 in the official minutes of the council. This subsection does not apply to appointed
- 24 <u>officer positions under section 40-14-04.</u>

3	40-0	09-17. Restrictions on members of board.
4	1.	Except as provided in subsection 2this section, a member of the board of city
5		commissioners may not:
6		a. Be eligible to any other office the salary of which is payable out of the city
7		treasury;
8		b. Hold any other office under the city government; and
9		c. Hold a position of remuneration in the employment of the city.
10	2.	A member of a board of city commissioners may serve as an ambulance crew member
11		employed by the city or under a contract with the city and be remunerated for those
12		services or as a volunteer firefighter or ambulance crew member for the city and be
13		compensated for attending training or responding to emergency calls or may be
14		reimbursed for expenses incurred in attending training or in responding to emergency
15		calls.
16	<u>3.</u>	A member of the board of city commissioners in a city having a population of five
17		hundred or fewer may hold a position of remuneration in the employment of the city if
18		no other qualified individual is available to hold the position of remuneration at an
19		equal cost to the city. The decision to employ the member of the city commission must
20		receive the unanimous approval of the other members of the commission, and the
21		approval must be documented in the official minutes of the commission. This
22		subsection does not apply to appointed officer positions under section 40-15-05.
