- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-08-04.5 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the use of scopes on muzzleloading firearms for individuals over sixty-five
- 3 years of age.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-08-04.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 20.1-08-04.5. Governor's proclamation concerning the hunting of deer with

8 muzzleloading firearms.

9 The governor shall by proclamation provide for a muzzleloading firearm season following

10 the regular deer hunting season to hunt deer with muzzleloading firearms in the manner,

11 number, places, and times as the governor prescribes. Licenses to hunt deer with

12 muzzleloading firearms must be issued by the director by lottery as prescribed by the director.

13 The director shall issue two percent of the total white-tailed deer gun licenses available each

14 year to hunters with muzzleloading firearms. Of the two percent, one-half of the licenses issued

15 may be for antlered white-tailed deer. <u>Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an individual</u>

16 over sixty-five years of age who receives a license under this section and is in lawful

17 possession of a muzzleloading firearm may use a telescopic sight not to exceed four-power

18 magnification on the muzzleloading firearm when hunting deer.
