1 A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to consider studying methods of 2 workforce expansion, enhancement, enlistment, and retention through educational programs 3 and supports. 4 WHEREAS, incentives to undertake education and training in areas of workforce shortage 5 or needed occupational or technical skills areas are expected to be in demand and in short 6 supply in the future; and 7 WHEREAS, incentives help encourage the expeditious completion of study programs; and 8 WHEREAS, educational supports and programs motivate and assist students to complete 9 educational degrees rather than drop out; and 10 WHEREAS, educational supports and programs lessen the level of student debt and allow 11 graduates a broad range of employment choices; and 12 WHEREAS, debt elimination or remediation assistance would help encourage graduates to 13 stay in, locate or relocate to, and contribute as productive taxpayers to North Dakota 14 communities with workforce needs; 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 16 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 17 That the Legislative Management consider studying methods of workforce expansion, 18 enhancement, enlistment, and retention through educational programs and supports; and 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the study address the short- and long-term needs of the 20 state for a skilled and educated workforce through a variety of programs and incentives, 21 including scholarships and grants; no interest, low interest, and deferred payment loan 22 programs; academic and nonacademic cash awards; private partnership programs; paid 23 internships; pre-employment educational supports; state-paid tuition programs; retraining or

advanced training subsidies in needed workforce areas; encore programs to entice older

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- 1 workers and those with disabilities or special needs to return to educational programs or
- 2 employment; and public or private programs to address or eliminate barriers to education or
- 3 employment such as child care, language skills, or the purchase of tools; and
- 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 5 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 6 the Sixty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
