## **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1109**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 37-01-03 and 37-01-43, subsection 6 of
- 2 section 37-28-02, and 37-28-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the operation of
- 3 the North Dakota national guard.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 37-01-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6 amended and reenacted as follows:

37-01-03. Articles of uniform code of military justice applicable in state - Regulations
governing - Punishment for offenses while on duty.

9 The articles of uniform code of military justice governing the armed forces of the United 10 States as codified in the Manual for Courts-Martial, United States, 20122016 edition, are a part 11 of this title so far as the same are applicable and not modified by any provision of this title. A 12 person who commits an offense while on military duty, to include state active duty, may be tried 13 by a court-martial lawfully appointed even after such duty has terminated, and if found guilty, the 14 accused must be punished according to the articles of uniform code of military justice and the 15 rules and regulations governing the armed forces of the United States and within the limits 16 prescribed in this title and by federal law for the courts-martial in the national guard. In any case 17 in which the person alleged to have committed the offense could be charged either under the 18 code of military justice or the civil law of this state, the officer whose duty it is to approve such 19 charge, in the officer's discretion, may order the person charged or subject to being charged to 20 be turned over to the civil authorities for trial. Commanders may administer nonjudicial 21 punishment for offenses while on military duty, to include state active duty, in accordance with 22 part V, Manual for Courts-Martial, except that the servicemember may not demand a trial by 23 courts-martial. Whenever reference is made to the articles of uniform code of military justice, to 24 the military service, or to the armed forces of the United States, such reference shall be

1 deemed to include the military service of this state. The intent of this title and of all laws of this

2 state affecting the military forces is to conform to all acts and regulations of the United States

3 affecting the same subjects, and all laws of this state shall be construed to effect this purpose.

4 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 37-01-43 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **37-01-43. North Dakota military civil relief act.** 

7 A person called or ordered to active service for thirty consecutive days or longer has all of

8 the protections afforded to persons in the military service of the United States under the

9 Servicemembers Civil Relief Act [50 App. U.S.C. sections 501-59650 U.S.C. sections

10 <u>3901-4043</u>] in effect on December 31, <del>2014</del><u>2016</u>.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 37-28-02 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

13 14  "Period of service" means the period of time beginning December 5, 1992, and ending June 30, <del>2017</del>2019.

15 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 37-28-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is

16 amended and reenacted as follows:

17 **37-28-03.** Payment of adjusted compensation for domestic and foreign service.

18 Each national guard or reserve component resident veteran mobilized stateside is entitled 19 to fifty dollars for each month or major fraction thereof for domestic service. Each national 20 guard, reserve, or active component resident veteran of foreign service who received the 21 expeditionary medal or campaign badge is entitled to one hundred dollars for each month or 22 major fraction thereof. If the veteran received a purple heart for foreign service, the veteran is 23 entitled to a payment of two thousand five hundred dollars in lieu of monthly payments for 24 adjusted compensation related to the mobilization during which the purple heart was earned. If 25 the veteran is deceased, the veteran's beneficiary is entitled to any payments under this chapter 26 to which the veteran would have been entitled. Applications for adjusted compensation may be 27 filed with the adjutant general through June 30, 20172019, or in the case of a soldier mobilized 28 on June 30, 20172019, not later than six months after the end of the mobilization period of 29 service.
